Tuesday, January 10th – Read Luke 3:8, Isaiah 51:2, Luke 19:9, Romans 4:11-12, 16-17; Romans 9:7-8.

Wednesday, January 10th – Read Luke 3:11, Isaiah 58:8, Ezekiel 18:7

Thursday, January 11th – Read Luke 3:14, Exodus 23:1, Leviticus 19:11

Friday, January 12th – Read Luke 3:21, Matthew 14:23, Mark 1:35, 6:46; Luke 5:16, 6:12, 9:18, 28.

Saturday, January 13th – Read Luke 3:22, Isaiah 42:1, John 1:32-33, Acts 10:38.
