

This week we will look at Luke 9:28-36, the Transfiguration. Each day we will focus on one or two verses and I'll give you the heading for that verse. Take the Scripture for the day and answer the following 4 questions:

- What does it say about God?
- What does it say about Human beings?
- What does it say about Creation?
- What does it say about the relationship between creation, God, and humanity (and how do the other passages connect to the theme verse from Luke—always the first listed each day)?

Monday February 27th – *Read Luke 9:28.* Jesus leaves the crowds and his teaching/healing ministry to go and pray. He brings Peter, James and John. *Is there any significance to these specific disciples?*

Tuesday, February 28th – *Read Luke 9:29.* In the process of praying on the mountain, Jesus is changed. *What do the descriptions of what happens to Jesus symbolize who Jesus really is?*

Wednesday, March 1st – *Read Luke 9:30-33a.* After Jesus is transfigured, Elijah and Moses appear in the cloud with him. *What do these specific people represent in the cloud with Jesus?*

Thursday, March 2nd - *Read Luke 9:33b.* Peter reacts to the scene and gives a suggestion of what they should do. *Is Peter trying to cover things up or celebrate a miracle? Why do you think this?*

Friday, March 3rd - *Read Luke 9:34-35.* There is a voice that comes from the cloud that does not come from anyone who has been named. *The voice is very similar to another time Jesus was surrounded by water (Remember that clouds are water in vapor form.) How do these two accounts connect?*

Saturday, March 4th- *Read Luke 9:36.* The cloud fades and the voice is silent and in “those days” the disciples didn’t tell anyone what they had seen. *I find this interesting because it means they were quiet about it until later, when they were speaking to churches and writing the Gospels.*

Look at the prayer list. Who can you pray for? Who needs a little extra help in an area where you can make a difference?
