

Questions for thought:

- What does the passage say about God?
- What does this passage say about human beings?
- What does this passage say about creation, the environment?
- What does this passage say about the relationship between creation, God, and humanity and how they connect at the "table?"

Monday June 5th

Read Ecclesiastes 9:7. God has already approved you, so eat and drink!

Tuesday June 6th

Read Psalm 107:9. God has satisfied the thirsty and hungry soul and filled you with what is good. There is a connection between feeding the soul and the body.

Wednesday June 7th

Read Genesis 1:29-30. What was the spirit in which creation was given to sustain humanity?

Thursday June 8th

Read Genesis 18:6. Hospitality, for Abraham it was a sacred duty to feed travelers. What sacred duty remains for Christians today in terms of letting someone join our table?

Friday June 9th

Read Proverbs 27:7. When we don't use rules to exclude others what sort of freedom emerges? (The relationship between heart and stomach).

Saturday June 10th

Read Ezekiel 24:10. Here is another example of instructions to prepare the food safely. Why might boiling the meat be the best way to prepare it? (Not necessarily by taste or flavor!)
