Monday June 26th

Genesis 30:30. Jacob is speaking to Laban about fairness. Laban is tricking him by working in the fields and managing his crops without allowing Jacob to grow rich, only as a payment to marry his daughters.

Tuesday June 27th

Thessalonians 3:10. The willingness to work is a prerequisite to eat. How might this passage be taken out of context to abuse the poor? Should we be the judges of others to determine who is worthy to eat?

Wednesday June 28th

Genesis 43:25. The celebration and welcoming is always done at a dinner table. Why do you think that is?

Thursday June 29th

John 6:27. What is the food that "perishes" that Jesus is talking about? What is the relationship between spoiled food and the person who eats it?

Friday June 30th

Exodus 32:20. How was this an appropriate punishment for the idolatry? How did this convey a message about the true power of idols?

Saturday July 1st

Genesis 47:15. Were people planning for the future and setting aside food? What lesson is in this story for us today?
