Read Genesis 17:5. Abram (high father) to Abraham, (father of a multitude)

Tuesday October 10th

Read Genesis 17:15. Sarai (my princess) to Sarah (mother of nations, note: Not "mother of dragons or Kaleesi")

Wednesday October 11th

Read Genesis 32:28. Jacob (supplanter) to Israel "having power with God."

Thursday October 12th

Read John 1:42. Simon (God has heard) to Peter (Rock)

Friday October 13th

Read Acts 13:9 and 1 Corinthians 9:19-23. Saul (Hebrew name) to Paul (Roman name). There is no specific meaning behind the change in name for reference but the truth is probably in the Corinthian passage. What do you think?

Saturday October 14th

Read Revelation 2:17. What about you? What is your name? What would your "new" name be? What element of faith would you like God to push through your life and use for service?

Look at the prayer list. Who can you pray for? Who needs a little extra help in an area where you can make a difference?
