Jacob, Jacob. Read Genesis 46:1-4

Wednesday October 24th

Moses, Moses! Read Exodus 3:1-10

Thursday October 25th

Samuel! Samuel! Read 1 Samuel 3:1-10

Friday October 26th

Simon, Simon. Luke 22:31-32.

Saturday October 27th

Saul, Saul. Read Acts 9:1-19.

Bonus: Martha, Martha. Read Luke 10:38-42. While this is not a call for Martha into leadership, it is important that Jesus directly speaks to her in the double naming. It is a call into instruction and discipleship and might be appropriate to our own journey.
