Read John 1:16-17 and Psalm 85. For Tuesday through Friday this week, we will keep Psalm 85 in mind as we connect the ministry of Jesus to these themes of love, righteousness, faithfulness, and peace. What is the main theme or connection of the two readings today?

Wednesday December 13th

Read John 14:27 and Psalm 85. What is the main theme or connection between the two readings today? How would you see this theme lived out in the Christian life through action?

Thursday December 14th

Read Romans 1:16-17 and Psalm 85. What is the main theme or connection between the two readings today? How would you see this theme lived out in the Christian life through action?

Friday December 15th

Read 1 Corinthians 1:30 and Psalm 85. What is the main theme or connection between the two readings today? How would you see this theme lived out in the Christian life through action?

Saturday December 16th

Read Matthew 6:5-15 and Psalm 85. What is the main theme or connection between the two readings today? How would you see this theme lived out in the Christian life through action?
