



#### **THREE SECRETS**

In the on-line article, *The 3 Secrets to Radical Hospitality* by Edie Wadsworth, she outlines her secrets for offering radical hospitality in her home. They apply to offering radical hospitality in our church as well.

- 1. **It's NOT about your home.** We can't wait for our church grounds, our building, and our decorations to be perfect. *"Hospitality is not about inviting people into your perfect home, its about inviting them into your imperfect heart,"*
- 2. **It's NOT about your food.** We do like our food and table fellowship is powerful, but the food isn't the main thing. *"It's not about the food. Focus on people and the rest will work itself out."*
- **3.** It's NOT about you at all. When we want to show hospitality, we need to think about the other person first. *"But you will find yourself with a full and beautiful life when you finally realize that it's not really about you at all."*

#### LOOSE CHANGE




